PURPOSE AND INTENT

The Town Board of the Town of Canaan finds it necessary to amend Chapter 390 of the Canaan Town Code, as it pertains to the creation of certain no parking zones and vehicle weight limits in designated areas around Queechy Lake. The Town of Canaan finds that these amendments to the Town Code as enacted herein are necessary for the health, welfare and benefit of Town residents.

AUTHORIZATION

The Town Board of the Town of Canaan enacts this Local Law under the authority granted by:

1. Article IX of the New York State Constitution, §2 (c) (6) and (10).
2. New York Municipal Home Rule Law §10.

ENACTMENT

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Canaan that Article II of the Canaan Town Code be hereby amended as follows:

**ARTICLE II
No Parking Zones & Weight Limits**

§390-2. No Parking Zones.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on the north side of County Route 30 beginning at the Centerline Sta. 2+45L and extending easterly along the north side of Co. Rte. 30 a distance of 1,320 feet to Centerline Sta. 15+65L.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on the south side of County Route 30 beginning at Centerline Sta. 1+20R and extending easterly along the south (lake) side of County Route 30 a distance of 775 feet to Centerline Sta. 8+95R.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on the south side of County Route 30 beginning at Centerline Sta. 12+20R and extending easterly along the south (lake) side of County Rte. 30 a distance of 85 feet to Centerline Sta. 13+05R.
- D. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on the south side of County Route 30 beginning at Centerline Sta. 14+20R and extending easterly along the south (lake) side of Co. Rte. 30 a distance of 3,130 feet to Centerline Sta. 45+50R.
- E. The Columbia County DPW – Highway Division shall be authorized to post those areas delineated in subsections §390-2(a)-(d) with "no parking" signs in accordance with the Federal MUTCD Manual/NYS Supplement.

§390-3. Vehicle Weight Limits.

Trucks, commercial vehicles, tractor-trailers and any other vehicles in excess of five (5) tons may not travel on County Route 30 between the intersection of County Route 30/State Route 295 and County Route 30/State Route 22. Vehicles making local deliveries or pickups and vehicles being utilized in agricultural activities are exempt from this section.

SEVERABILITY

In the event that any word, phrase or part of this local law shall be declared unconstitutional, the same shall be severed and separated from the remainder of this local law and shall not effect the remainder of said local law which shall remain in full force and effect.
